

AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF DALE, Cambria County, Pa.,  
REGULATING AND RESTRICTING OUTDOOR FIRES WITHIN THE BOROUGH  
OF DALE, AND PRESCRIBING PENALTIES FOR THE VIOLATION THEREOF.

BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED, and it is hereby ordained and enacted  
by the Council of the BOROUGH OF DALE, Cambria County, Pa.,

SECTION 1 - No person or persons shall set or maintain any fire upon any  
of the streets, sidewalks, or alleys in the BOROUGH OF DALE, or burn or cause  
to be burned thereon any paper, boxes, rubbish, leaves or other material or  
substance of any kind.

SECTION 2 - Out-of-door fires shall be permitted, upon private property  
in the Borough, provided that the following regulations and restrictions are  
strictly adhered to: No such out-of-door fire shall be built unless it is  
properly gaurded. No such fire shall be allowed to burn upon any day, except  
between sunrise and sunset.

SECTION 3 - Any person who shall violate or fail to conform to any of  
the provisions of this ordinance shall, upon conviction thereof, be sentenced  
to pay a fine of not more than twenty dollars (\$20.00) and costs of prosecution,  
and, in default of payment of such fine and costs, to imprisonment for not more  
than ten (10) days.

SECTION 4 - That any ordinance or part of ordinance conflicting with this  
Ordinance be and the same is hereby repealed inssofar as the same affects this  
Ordinance.
